Behaviour Policy – Returning to school, June 2020 (COVID-19)

Expectations of Children

- Normal behaviour rules/rewards/sanctions apply – ‘East Dene Golden Rules’
- Rewards such as ‘Fun Time Friday’ to be conducted in class – any child missing time from this reward to be asked to sit outside the classroom, 2 metres apart
- Children should stay at a social distance as much as possible (adults in school to remind children when necessary, visual prompts to be displayed around school)
- Children should not play games that involve touching others (e.g. tiggy, stuck in the mud etc...)
- Children struggling to adhere to the No Touching rules will be reminded and parents informed to support with reinforcement
- Sanctions, including loss of minutes, to be in place for children who intentionally break social distancing rules
- Any extreme behaviour linked to COVID-19 e.g. coughing/spitting intentionally on another pupil will be taken very seriously and will result in the child being sent home to continue home learning for an extended period of time
- Children to line up at a social distance when asked
- Children to enter the building separately and patiently
- Children to wash their hands/sanitise when entering the building and on entering their learning space as well as at regular intervals throughout the day
- Children to follow any signs and special routes in place (e.g. one way systems)
- Children not to bring any items from home into school, unless prior permission has been granted by a senior leader. Any items brought into school without permission are to be removed immediately, sanitized and placed in a bag for parents/carers to collect – class teacher to decide on an appropriate sanction (if necessary) and parents asked to support with reinforcement of the rule.
