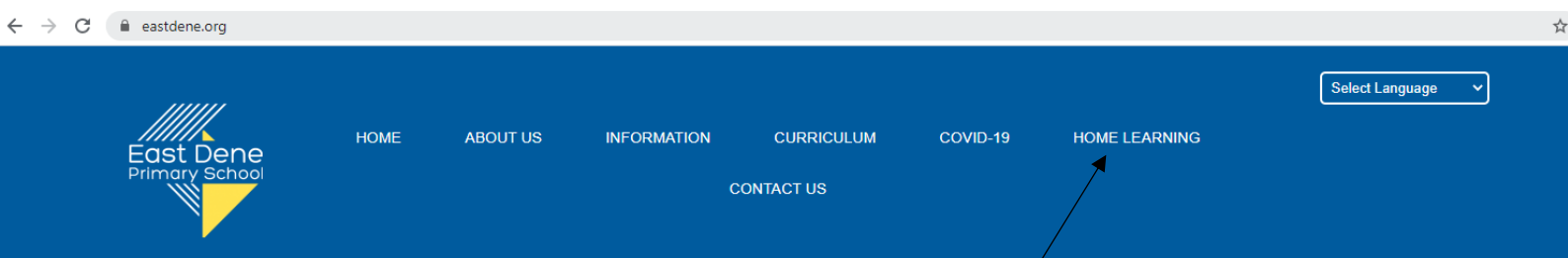


Home learning guide
