

Reading Questionnaire Responses (54 responses)

Thank you to those parents/carers who took the time to respond the reading questionnaire sent out. If you have any questions about your child's reading, please do not hesitate to speak with your child's class teacher.

Here is an overview of the responses submitted:

- 85% of parents/carers say that their child enjoys reading
- 90% of children read at least weekly with 60% reading 3 or more times per week
- 85% of pupils take a reading book and diary home every day
- 90% of parents feel their child is well supported with their reading
- 85% of parents/carers agree that reading is a priority at ED
- Parents/carers know this through reading rewards and celebrations, reading events held across the year and through their child talking about the books they are reading

Based on feedback given we have made some changes:

We have now spent additional money on even more books to ensure a wider range of books are available to your child.

We will now be updating Dojo every Friday with our Read Every Day winners and our reader of the week winners.

These are the days that your child will be changing their reading book/s:

Foundation Stage

F1 change/send home a picture book every Friday.

F2 change their reading book and reading for pleasure book on Mondays and Fridays.

Y1/2

Your child can change their reading book after they have read it 3 times. This can be changed by them or with the support of a member of staff if needed.

Reading for pleasure books will be changed and sent home every Friday.

Y3/4 and Y5/6

Both reading for pleasure and reading books will be changed every Tuesday but additional opportunities are given across the week where needed. Your child's teacher monitors this.
