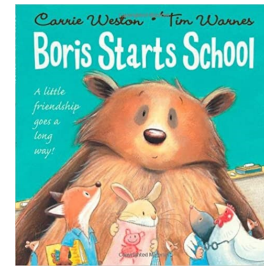
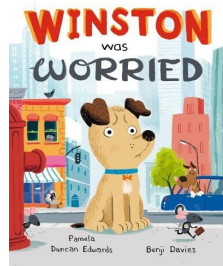
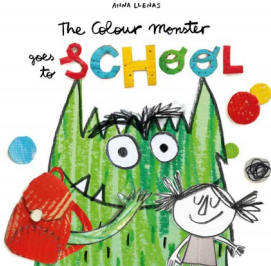


EYFS & KS1 East Dene Reading Newsletter #10
