

# Resources and Training for Special Educational Need



## **Staff Training:**

At East Dene, we make sure all our members of staff are provided with the correct trainings, so they can deliver effective teaching strategies to support individuals with needs. Each class has a TA to provide additional support for the pupils with SEN, disabilities or other additional needs.

Some training undergone by our staff are:

- Autism
- Dyslexia
- Dyspraxia
- Bonding through play
- PECS

## **Resources:**

The SENCo has a yearly budget, which is spent effectively to buy equipment for the children with Special educational needs. It is spent on a wide range of equipment such as:

- Writing slopes
- Moving sit slope cushions
- Pencil grips
- Coloured overlays for reading
- Coloured paper books for both Maths and English (for dyslexic children)
- Sensory toys such as trampolines, peanut balls and sensory boards to support children regulate

We also have a sensory room, which is enjoyed by children who will go into crisis and need a place to regulate. This room can be used at any point of the day depending on the child's needs.
