Re: Admissions Policy Consultation 2025-26

The Directors of the Central Learning Partnership Trust (CLPT) are consulting on the admission arrangements for Coleridge Primary, Eastwood Village Primary and East Dene Primary schools. The consultation, with regards to the proposed changes to the Admissions Policy for admission to these schools from September 2025, is commencing on Monday 20 November 2023 and will conclude at midday on Monday 8 January 2024.

These arrangements will apply for pupils who will be starting primary school in September 2025, or those requesting admission to the schools from September 2025 onwards.

The admission arrangements will be administered on behalf of the CLPT by Rotherham Council (RMBC).

We would welcome your views on the proposed arrangements; there are no changes from those agreed for previous academic years.
