# POLICIES

- Uniform:
- *Our uniform comprises of a blue sweatshirt or cardigan, a white polo shirt and either black or grey trousers or a skirt or pinafore dress. For safety reasons we ask that children wear sensible shoes, not flip flops, crocs or shoes with a high heel. Please ensure that all items of clothing, including coats and shoes, are clearly labelled with your child's name.*
- *For PE activities we ask that children wear black shorts, a white t-shirt and plimsolls or trainers. For outdoor PE in colder weather, a black tracksuit bottoms and a black sweatshirt are required. No hoods are allowed on their PE kits for safety reasons.*

- We pride ourselves on promoting a love of reading at East Dene.
- Shared read takes place at least 4 times a week. Children can choose from our famous five books – vote for story
- All children to take their reading books and diary every day to read at home. Reading books will be changed weekly every Friday for children. This will contain a dream read to be read by adults at bedtime to your child and a reading book that your child needs to read to you.
- Children to complete the reading chart each morning when they arrive to tick off that they have read at home. (RED chart)
- We encourage our children to read at least 4 times at home and rewards are given in class for those who achieve this.

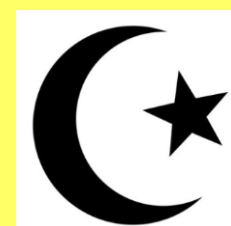

# E-SAFETY TIPS

## The Legends' Code

- 1. Think before you share

Your child learned about how quickly things can be shared online and why it's important to only share things they'd be happy for everyone to see.

- 2. Protect your stuff

Your child learned what tools are available to keep their stuff safe online – passwords, privacy settings and more – and why they are so important.

- 3. Check it's for real

Your child learned that not everything you see online is true and heard some tips for spotting online scams. We told your child that if they're not sure about something, they should always check with you.

- 4. Respect each other

Your child heard about how important it is to treat other people the way they want to be treated online. They learned how to report bad behaviour and abuse.
