We are delighted to share that the new playground will be completed over the weekend! To celebrate, we will be holding a special assembly on Monday, where we will officially open the playground and give all the children the opportunity to enjoy it for the first time.

We would also like to say a huge thank you for all your feedback about our end-of-day collection routines. We received so many responses, and your comments and votes have been incredibly helpful in shaping our next steps.

Following your overwhelming feedback, families have chosen to collect pupils from their classroom doorways. From Monday, the new collection arrangements will be as follows:

- EYFS – Continue as usual.
- Year 1 – 3:10pm from the staffroom door.
- Year 2 – 3:10pm from the dinner hall entrance.
- Year 3 – 3:10pm from the KS2 entrance.
- Year 4 – 3:20pm from the staffroom door.
- Year 5 – 3:20pm from Mrs Spafford's fire exit.
- Year 6 – 3:20pm from Mrs Allen's fire doors.
- Children that can walk home without an adult will be released from the main entrance at 3:20pm

Mr Tankard and Miss Wild will be on the playground to help direct you to the right doorway.

If you have children to collect at both 3:10pm and 3:20pm, please arrive at 3:20pm to collect all of your children at once. We do not want anyone waiting outside in the cold unnecessarily. Staff will ensure that younger pupils are safely supervised until they are collected.

Thank you again for your continued support and feedback. We are really looking forward to sharing the new playground with the children and continuing to make improvements that benefit our school community. We are really grateful for all your support and help.
